

# CORONAVIRUS (2019–nCoV)

## TRAVELLERS' ADVICE

Several cases of 2019-nCoV have been reported in the Chinese city of Wuhan.

We recommend that you regularly check the **Conseils aux voyageurs**<sup>1</sup> (Travellers' advice) section for China to **see which regions are affected** and to inform the French Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs of your trip via the Ariane website<sup>2</sup>.

### DURING YOUR STAY

#### Follow local recommendations

It is recommended that you :

- **Avoid all contact with living or dead animals, including at markets;**
- **Avoid all close contact with people suffering from fever and coughs;**
- **Avoid eating uncooked or rare meat;**
- **Regularly wash your hands with soap or an alcohol–based sanitizer.**

**Should you experience symptoms of a respiratory infection (fever, cough, breathing difficulties), it is recommended that you quickly see a local doctor,** wear a surgical mask if you are in contact with other people, use disposable tissues and wash your hands regularly.

### UPON ARRIVAL IN FRANCE

Should you experience symptoms of a respiratory infection (fever, cough, breathing difficulties), it is recommended that you :

- **Wear a surgical mask** if you are in contact with other people;
- **Use disposable tissues and wash your hands regularly;**
- **Quickly contact the Samu (French emergency medical services, call "15"),** notifying them that you have been to Wuhan and describing your symptoms. Do not go to your GP or to the hospital to avoid the risk of transmission.
